Warranty Description

Simply Street Bikes (SSB) will cover 100% of the labor and 100% of the retail price of parts for the covered systems that fail during the warranty period. All work must be done by SSB.

What Is Covered

- Engine: All internally lubricated parts. Crankshaft and bearings, oil pump, internal timing gears or chain/belt, camshaft and bearings, valve lifters, rocker arm assemblies and push rods, valve guides, pistons and rings, wrist pins, and connecting rods. Engine block and cylinder heads covered only if damage is caused by failure of an internally lubricated part.
- Transmission: All internally lubricated parts contained in the housings. Case housings are covered if damaged by the failure of an internally lubricated part.
- Seals and Gaskets: Seals and gaskets are covered when replaced in conjunction with a covered failure.
- Electrical: Alternator/generator, stator, regulator rectifier, starter motor, electronic fuel injection sensors and injectors, electronic ignition module, battery (unless battery has not been properly maintained).
- Brakes: Master cylinder, disk brake calipers and basic ABS components.
- Suspension: Rear shock, fork seals and bushings
- Cooling: Engine cooling fan and motor, water pump and thermostat.
- Towing: Within 100 miles of SSB provided the towing is done by SSB, during normal business hours with appointment

What Is Not Covered

- Damage resulting from crashing or tipping over or any external damage or road hazard, or damage being caused by a covered or warranted part.
- Warranty is VOID if motorcycle is crashed, laid down, or dumped after date of sale.
- Repairs done at another shop or by another person, not done by SSB
- Any mechanical breakdown or failure that occurs to or results from non-standard (OEM) or high performance parts or electrical alterations
- Any part covered by insurance, manufacturer warranty, or recall program, whether the recall was completed or not
- Any vehicle if the odometer has been tampered with or disconnected
- Any mechanical breakdown caused by overheating, or resulting from inadequate amounts of coolant, lubricants or fluids, sludge, rust, residue or corrosion, lack or loss of oil or lubricant, an unsafe engine operating temperature as indicated by gauges, warning lights, or audible warning sounds.
- Any vehicle used for any form of competitive driving or racing, or any vehicle used for stunting, including wheelies, stoppies or endos

What Is Not Covered (continued)

- During the period of this warranty it may become necessary to: replace/repair spark plugs, filters, clutch assembly, brake and clutch linings, hoses, light bulbs, wheels, tires, or adjust carburetors. These services and replacements are required because of normal wear and use and are not covered by this warranty.
- Losses resulting from delays or failures caused by acts of God, accidental loss or damage, collision or upset, falling objects, fire, theft, larceny, explosion, lightning, earthquake, windstorm, hail, water, flood, freezing, malicious mischief or vandalism, war, riot or civil commotion, or other causes beyond the control of SSB.
- Incidental or consequential damages, such as loss of time, inconvenience or loss of use of the covered vehicle, or injury or death to any persons.
- A part or component that a repair facility may recommend replacing but which has not failed.
- Maintenance services and parts
- Body repair, squeaks, rattles or wind noise
- Damage to a covered part resulting from a mechanical breakdown or failure of a non-covered part, or from faulty or negligent repairs
- Limit of Liability (Aggregate) – The aggregate total of all repairs shall not exceed the vehicle purchase price.
- Repairs not reported to SSB before the Warranty Period expires
- The following items, including: minor dampness or leaks or regular wear/maintenance items, gauges and gauge cluster, chain, sprocket, brake pads, clutch and all clutch parts or other wearable items

How To Obtain Repairs

- 1) Prevent Further Damage: Take immediate action to prevent further damage to the vehicle. Any damage resulting from continued operation will not be covered.
- 2) Return your vehicle to SSB at the address shown above for repair. Any repairs done at another shop or by another person shall not be reimbursed.
- 3) Parts will be repaired or replaced with new parts or good condition used parts at the discretion of SSB

Cancellation

- Cancellation – Warranty is VOID and cancelled if motorcycle is crashed, laid down, or dumped after date of sale. Warranty has no cash value and no refund will be given to customer.
